

Youth Sport Camps Camp Policies



Attendance Policy

Your camp payment entitles your child to attend camp for one week. Unfortunately, we are unable to arrange make-up days for children who are forced to miss one or more days during that week.

Camper Cancellation/Absence

If a camper or camper's family must cancel their registration for a session, they will be charged a \$30 cancellation fee per session, and the remainder of their deposit or payment will be refunded. Absences may not be made up in another session, and no part of the Camp fee is refundable when an enrolled camper is absent.

Discipline Policy

The YSC staff will deal with the normal day to day minor behavioral problems. Excessive and very disruptive behaviors, such as physically or verbally hurting other children, property damage, stealing, use of foul or vulgar language, or leaving camp grounds without parental permission, will be handled in the following manner:

- First Time – The child will be isolated from the other children
- Second Time – The parent will be called
- Third Time – The child will not be allowed to enter the program for at least 2 days
- Fourth Time – The child will not be allowed to return to the program for the duration of the summer

In extreme behavior cases wherein another camper or staff member is determined to be at risk, YSC administration reserves the right to move immediately to a higher step of the disciplinary plan, if such action is deemed necessary. No refunds will be given if a camper is removed from the camp for disciplinary reasons.

Field Trips

For Super Sport Camps, a field trip is scheduled for each two-week session. In general, itineraries will be provided for these days well in advance of the activity. It is the camper's responsibility to be on the bus at the appointed time. Buses will ALWAYS leave at the designated time – NO EXCEPTIONS. If a camper misses the bus, it is the camper's responsibility to arrange alternate transportation to the activity. Refunds will not be given for missed field trips. We will maintain a camper : staff ratio of 5 : 1 or less on all off-campus field trips.

First Aid

All staff members are certified in First Aid & CPR. Minor injuries will be treated by YSC staff members, and parents/guardians will be notified. In the event of a more serious injury, parents will be notified immediately, and campers will be transported to the nearest emergency care facility. In the best interest of your child, as well as the other children and the staff, please do not send your child to the program when he/she is ill. Also, be sure to keep your emergency telephone number/contact information up-to-date.

If your child needs to take any medication while at the program, you MUST have a doctor's permission slip. This must state the type of medication, the dosage and be addressed to the YSC. The medication MUST be in its original container.

Food

Campers are expected to bring a sack lunch on Monday-Thursday. No glass bottles, please. Lunch (pizza) will be provided on Fridays, but campers must provide their own beverage. If a camper forgets or loses his/her lunch, we will be sure that the camper has something to eat, but this is a "special circumstances" effort, and it should not be abused. It is important that if a child has food allergies that this be communicated with the staff so appropriate steps can be taken to ensure safety.

Forms

Each camper must have a completed "Emergency Contact and Health Form" on file before the first day of camp. Campers without this form (completed and signed) will not be able to participate.

Inclement Weather

In case of inclement weather (extremely hot, rain, tornado, etc.), quality alternate indoor activities will be scheduled. Alternate days/make-up sessions/refunds will not be made.

Lost and Found

YSC is not responsible for any lost items. For your convenience, we maintain a **Lost and Found Bin** at each of the camp sites (Moby and South College). It is your responsibility to check these bins for lost items. Valuable items are stored in the camps office. Items are kept in storage until October, after which they are donated to local charities. Please label all of your child's items. We will attempt to contact families for all labeled items.

NOTE: Please do not allow your child to bring electronic games, expensive toys, trading cards, excessive amounts of money, or any other valuable or distracting items. Campers will be busy all day, so such items are not necessary, and are often misplaced. YSC is not responsible for any lost items.

Medications

The YSC staff is not responsible for providing or administering medication to children. In certain situations, our staff members may be willing to assist, but the YSC cannot be held liable for such actions. Please consult the camp director for assistance.

Payment

Payment must be made on or before the first day of camp. Campers will not be able to attend camp without payment.

Pick Up and Drop Off

Campers must be signed in and out every day. They cannot simply be dropped off in the parking lot. Failure to do this may result in the camper being dismissed from camp.

Program Cancellation

If any camp session must be cancelled due to low enrollment or other unforeseeable circumstance, all camp tuition for that session will be refunded in full.

Session Transfer

If a camper or camper's family chooses to switch sessions, a \$15 transfer fee will be charged if the transfer is made within one week of the session. If the transfer is made more than one week in advance, no fee will be assessed.

Suspension and Dismissal

The following will be considered grounds for suspension or dismissal:

- Failure to pay tuition
- Continued disruptive behavior by a camper after corrective measures have been taken
- Repeated late pickup/abuse of camp hours
- Failure to provide required emergency and medical information

Times

Official camp times are 8:30am-4:30 pm. Care during this time span is covered by tuition. Please be sure to honor these hours. Before- and after-camp supervision is offered at an additional cost (7:30-8:30am and 4:30-5:30pm), and this care must be paid for at the time of service or in advance. Please contact the camp director for arrangements.
